

**DIRECTIONS TO OSF ST. FRANCIS MEDICAL CENTER
COMING FROM THE WEST (I.E., DES MOINES OR GALESBURG)**

Coming from the West on I-74 (i.e., Des Moines, Galesburg),

- Take **Exit 92B (Glen Oak Avenue)** – stay to your left.
- Turn left at the traffic signal on **Glen Oak Avenue**.
- Continue on Glen Oak Avenue, crossing **Spalding**, going straight through the stop sign.
- While on Glen Oak, you will need to drive almost to the end of the hospital complex until you see the **North Building** (six story older building) on the right.
- Turn right, into the parking area beyond the North Building. There will be a parking deck straight ahead. (It is called **Medi-Park 3** – there are no signs indicating that name). The gates are supposed to be up over the weekend for you to park, however, we have been having problems with the gates being down..
- If the gates are down and you cannot get into Medi-Park 3, go **back** down Glen Oak Avenue and turn left at the stop sign. You may park in **Medi-Park 2** for the evening. (We will get you a free parking card on Monday morning for the remainder of your visit here).

You will be staying in the North Building, however, the front doors will probably be locked over the weekend. Walk back down Glen Oak to the main entrance of the hospital (same side of street as North Building – directly across the street from the picnic tables). Go the security desk, which is inside and up the stairs. You can use their phone to page the resident who will then take you to your dorm-like room and give you your key.

**DIRECTIONS TO OSF ST. FRANCIS MEDICAL CENTER
COMING FROM THE EAST (I.E., INDIANAPOLIS OR BLOOMINGTON)**

Coming from the East on I-74 (i.e., Indianapolis, Bloomington).

- Take **Exit 92B (Glen Oak Avenue)**, which is the second exit after crossing the Murray Baker bridge. 92B will have a short exit ramp.
- At end of ramp, turn left onto **Spalding Avenue**.
- At the first stop light turn right onto **Glen Oak Avenue** going straight through the stop sign.
- While on Glen Oak Avenue, you will need to drive almost to the end of the hospital complex until you see the **North Building** (six story older building) on the right.
- Turn right, into the parking area beyond the North Building. There will be a parking deck straight ahead. (It is called **Medi-Park 3** – there are no signs indicating that name). The gates are supposed to be up over the weekend for you to park, however, we have been having problems with the gates being down.
